Join us to visit a land conservation success story made possible by the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection's Open Space & Watershed Land Acquisition Program (OSWA) - funded by the Community Investment Act - and other local investments.

Grand Acres is among the few urban gardens that the Land Trust owns. It is used by two dozen community gardeners, fifteen Incubator Gardeners, and our twelve Growing Entrepreneurs. The Land Trust recently expanded the parcel and invested in several infrastructural improvements, including a beautiful fence (built by the Growing Entrepreneurs), a heated greenhouse, and tiered garden sections.

Enjoy a walk on the site and talk with State legislators, elected officials, land trust representatives, and community leaders about state, regional, and local conservation priorities. The event is free to members and others who are interested. Inclement weather cancels.
